Across the Pond

This year Troy has a number of opportunities to help teach in seminars using GoodSeed resources. Along with others, he will be teaching church leaders and lay people both the Gospel as presented in GoodSeed resources, and how to use these resources to reach others. GoodSeed's goal is to clearly communicate a biblical



worldview using a chronological approach to Scripture. Troy will be involved in four such seminars this vear: Olds, Alberta (Apr. 17-19); London, England (May 6-8); Owen Sound, Ontario (Sept.

The London seminar will be Troy's first trip to Europe (he's just a little excited), and while there, he will also be starting into one of his primary roles as videographer. He will be conducting and recording some interviews of people who have used GoodSeed's resources very effectively in their ministries. Since we first felt God's call to join GoodSeed, one of the major things we have been praying about is housing. We knew at the time that the housing market in Alberta was very tight. We heard stories from co-workers about the challenges of just finding a place to rent, yet alone affordable places to buy. However, the housing market in Alberta has been changing even since our arrival. More houses are coming on the market, but prices are still very high and mostly out of our reach. We are praying that conditions will change and that we may be able to purchase our first home within the next year or two. The Lord has been very good to us in providing money towards a down payment, but we still have quite a ways to go in saving for this huge purchase. In the meantime, we're still searching for a suitable and affordable place to rent. Please pray for wisdom and the finances required for such a purchase, and that an affordable place to rent would become available in the meantime.
