With that in mind, here's what we're looking ahead to in 2012.

GoodSeed: The trips Troy was to have taken in 2011 had to be postponed till 2012, but tickets have now been purchased for a trip to Asia in the Spring for a team of staff, including Troy. He will be travelling in India for two weeks to help teach seminars and video the work being done there. GoodSeed has asked each member of the team to raise funds for their portion of the trip (a minimum of \$1500), so please pray with us as we look to the Lord for that provision. In the office, Troy is busy recording and editing video for an Interactive Edition of *By This Name*. This will enable the book to be used much more easily and effectively by folks as they teach the contents in their own Bible studies. Troy also helps maintain the GoodSeed website, where we have most of our products available for free download.

A new role he is excited about is that of Cyber Security Manager. GoodSeed is becoming increasingly involved in ministry within "creative access" countries, which necessitates a system of secure communication with those who are risking their livelihoods or even their lives to translate our materials into their language. Please pray that we would be "wise as serpents and innocent as doves" as we desire to minister to our dear brothers and sisters in these places.

Naomi is becoming increasingly busy in her Hospitality/Social Coordinator role. She enjoys assisting the ministry in this way, but sometimes finds it challenging to balance her responsibilities both within and outside the home.

digital book. Permission was granted. Due to the risks associated with being in such a country, often it is hard to pass on news of what is going on. But recently we received news via a secure source. The * indicates changes made for security reasons.

America). (A decade passed with no or minimal contact in-between.) There are now six multi-generation families that have come to Christ, with several of these new believers now having become themselves bold teachers of the Word. Our contact went on to request a staff member to visit to give further teaching (we are bombarded with such requests) and also inquired about a translation of our materials for another people group he is trying to reach in that closed country (another very common inquiry).

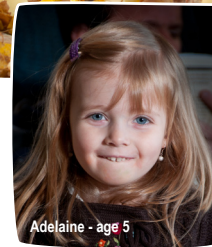
